INTERNATIONAL AND INDIAN ARTISTS CONVERGE IN INDIA'S NEW JAIPUR CENTRE FOR ART.

JAIPUR'S 18th-century City Palace, a maze of courtyards, latticed windows and marble columns, is now home to the new contemporary-art-focused Jaipur Centre for Art. Maharaja Sawai Padmanabh Singh, 26, who studied art history in Rome, partnered with Jaipur-based American curator Noelle Kadar, a veteran of India's contemporary art scene, to imagine a bold new exhibition space in a 2,600-square-foot palace wing that once served as a guesthouse for visiting dignitaries.
